





Investments in Education Programs in FY23 v. FY22




Majority Have Continued At Least Some Digital Education Programs Since Pandemic

Investment in Digital Education Programs Over the Next 2-3 Years







Status of Charging Fee for Education Programs




Change in Education Program Tuition Fees/Rates FY23 v. FY22





Half Earn Only Up To 5% of Org Earned Revenue from Education Tuition Fees










Majority of Education Funding Comes from
